Key Achievements

With years of focus on criminal defense, Xu Haibo handles cases involving traditional crimes, cybercrimes, tax-related offenses, and smuggling. Leveraging his prior experience in law enforcement, he has achieved exceptional outcomes in numerous cases.

Representative Cases:

- Successfully handled a fraud case against the Suzhou branch of an insurance company.
- Secured non-prosecution for three employees accused of provoking trouble during a corporate acquisition.
- Won exemption from punishment for a legal aid client charged with provoking trouble, resulting in immediate release.
- Defended a bar owner in an affray causing death; severed the causal link to the death, leading to non-arrest and reduced charges (1.5-year sentence despite protests from the victim's family).
- Advised a suspect in an organizing prostitution case, resulting in discretionary non-prosecution.
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- Obtained non-arrest for an executive in a training school fraud case (covered by provincial media), which was later dismissed.
- Defended the principal suspect in a case involving the provision of cyber intrusion tools (with over RMB 3 million in profits); successfully challenged forensic reports, securing probation with partial restitution.
- Negotiated bail and a reduced sentence for a defendant in a tea trading platform fraud case (involving over RMB 100 million).
- Argued for probation in a pyramid scheme case by proving that a mid-level employee was not an organizer.
- Achieved probation for a pharmaceutical executive in a major VAT fraud case (initially facing over 10 years in prison) through a partial guilty plea.
- Secured non-prosecution in an invoice fraud case by combining a not-guilty defense with allegations of upstream guilt.
- Prevented the transfer of a tax evasion case to judicial authorities by challenging penalty procedures through administrative reconsideration.
- Identified the actual controller in a major refined oil smuggling case through bank record analysis.
- Secured probation (2 years and 3 months) in a tire smuggling case by proving voluntary surrender.
- Achieved probation for a construction company employee in an embezzlement case through a not-guilty defense, despite the client's refusal to meet restitution demands.
